Madden Deluca Clinical and Research Fellowship in Pediatric Cardiac Intensive Care at the Stollery Children's Hospital, Edmonton, Alberta, Canada. 2-year fellowship beginning July 2016

We are pleased to accept applications from a broad range of candidates (prior training in cardiology, anesthesia, intensive care, neonatology, cardiac surgery) who wish to pursue a career or further training in pediatric cardiac intensive care. The position can be adapted to suit the needs and background of the candidate but there will be an emphasis on clinical or laboratory research in pediatric cardiac intensive care.

The Stollery Children's Hospital Pediatric Cardiac ICU is a separate stand-alone unit dedicated to the care of neonates and children with a broad range of congenital and acquired cardiovascular and pulmonary vascular diseases.

The Pediatric Cardiac ICU has active and well-supported programs in fellowshiptraining, QI and QA, Simulation, and Epidemiology of long term outcomes of complex neonatal and childhood disease.

The candidate will work with 8 dedicated and enthusiastic cardiac intensivists with backgrounds in pediatric cardiology, critical care and anesthesia.

The Cardiovascular Surgical program receives referrals from the whole of Western Canada and performs over 850 cardiac surgical procedures each year and all receive perioperative care on the Pediatric Cardiac ICU.

The Pediatric Cardiac ICU collaborates with internationally renowned programs to manage critically ill patients on ECMO, RVAD&LVAD support, pulmonary vascular disease and heart and lung transplantation and anticoagulation.
